Friendly Reminder

Video recording: Numerous video cameras are installed throughout Cummings Center and are used regularly to record activity at various building entryways, hallways, and other common areas. Although most of these cameras are *not* actively monitored, they provide valuable recorded footage in a variety of circumstances. Recently, in cooperation with Beverly Police Department, camera footage helped identify several individuals who vandalized building common areas. Anyone observing suspicious activity at any time is urged to immediately contact Beverly Police Department by calling **9-1-1**. While uniformed or plainclothes police

officers sometimes patrol the buildings and grounds, please remember that Cummings Properties does *not* provide security services.
